

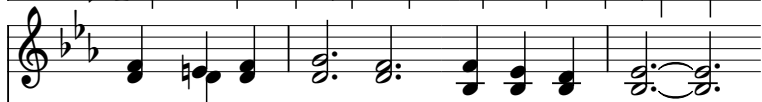

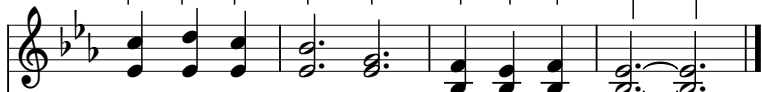
1.-4. Have Thine own way, Lord! Have Thine own way!
